Responsibilities:

Volunteers will help users utilize our Creation Space equipment in a 1:1 or small class setting:

- 3-D Printing (Creality3D Ender + ToyBox printers)
- Heat Press (Swing Design)
- Sewing Machine (Singer Heavy Duty 4423 + Singer 9960 Sewing & Quilting Machine)
- Vinyl Cutting (Silhouette Cameo 3 + 4)
- Video Production (Adobe Premiere)

Additional creative interests and home improvement / repair skills are also welcomed.

Qualifications:

1. Reliability, patience and a desire to create in camaraderie while sharing skills with other makers
2. Desire to make the Creation Space an inviting community destination, by helping to keep it clean, organized, and ensure the equipment is operational, etc.
3. Ability to commit to 1-2 hours per month.
