

Clickbait

- Even legitimate websites have "sponsored" clickbait
- Just like the carnival barker looking for suckers



Satire

- A dash of truth + exaggeration + sarcasm to make a point
- Some people cannot distinguish between fact and satire
- They share it as factual without the satire disclaimer

Its plaque debunks the story:




 Artist Mike Martino said the wings signify "the development of a young person's spirit and individuality."



Gaslighting

Photographs can be altered

 Adobe Photoshop and similar software can alter photographs to change their appearance and their very meaning



Videos can be deceiving

- Selective editing can change the overall message
- Snippets can be taken out of context to show exactly the opposite of what really happened
- Software can superimpose other faces over real faces and literally put words in other people's mouths
